Live Release Rate is calculated by dividing total live outcomes (adoptions, outgoing transfers, and return to owner/guardian) by total outcomes (total live outcomes plus euthanasia not including owner/guardian requested euthanasia or died/lost in shelter/care).

The Live Release Rate does not include 28 owner/guardian requested euthanasia, 17 animals that died or were lost in the shelter/care and 133 animals that were dead on arrival.

Save Rate is calculated by dividing Adjusted Euthanasia by Total Intake including animals in shelter/foster and subtracting the result from 1.

The **ACCT Foster Program** is one of the many life saving arms of the PSPCA. The primary reason for foster care is to provide a temporary home for a potentially adoptable animal whose current condition is not manageable in a shelter setting. PSPCA ACCT receives more animals than there is space, and so moving animals into foster homes not only saves them, but also the animal who gets their old cage space.
