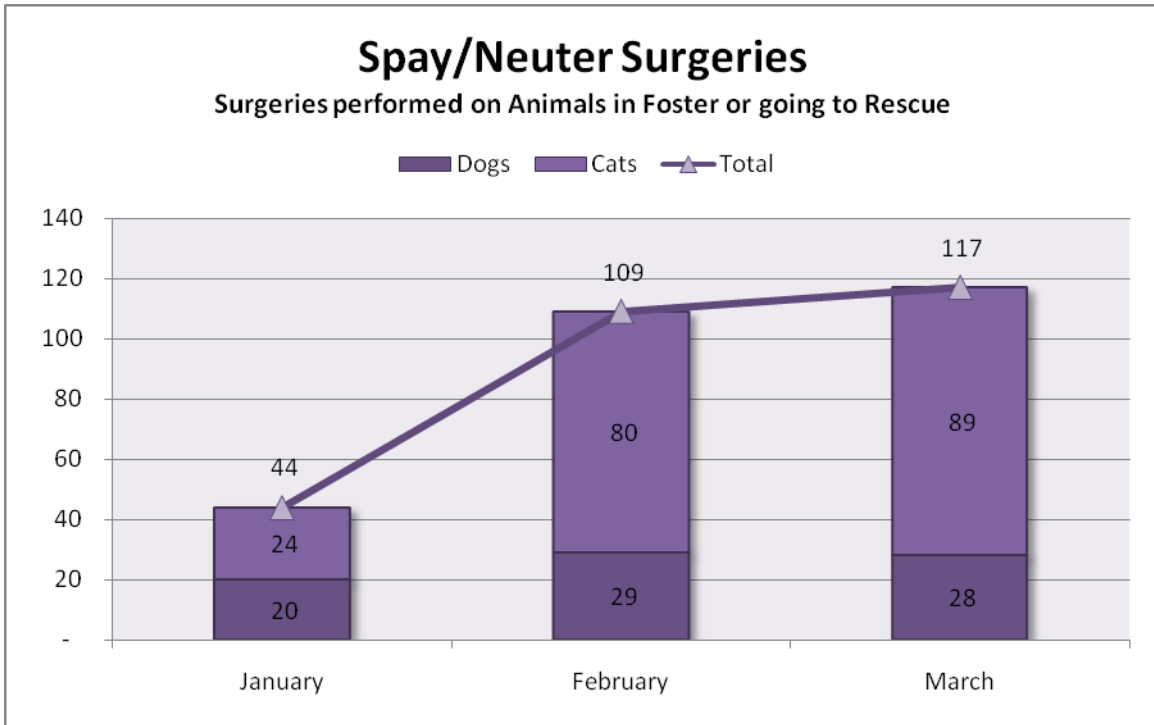
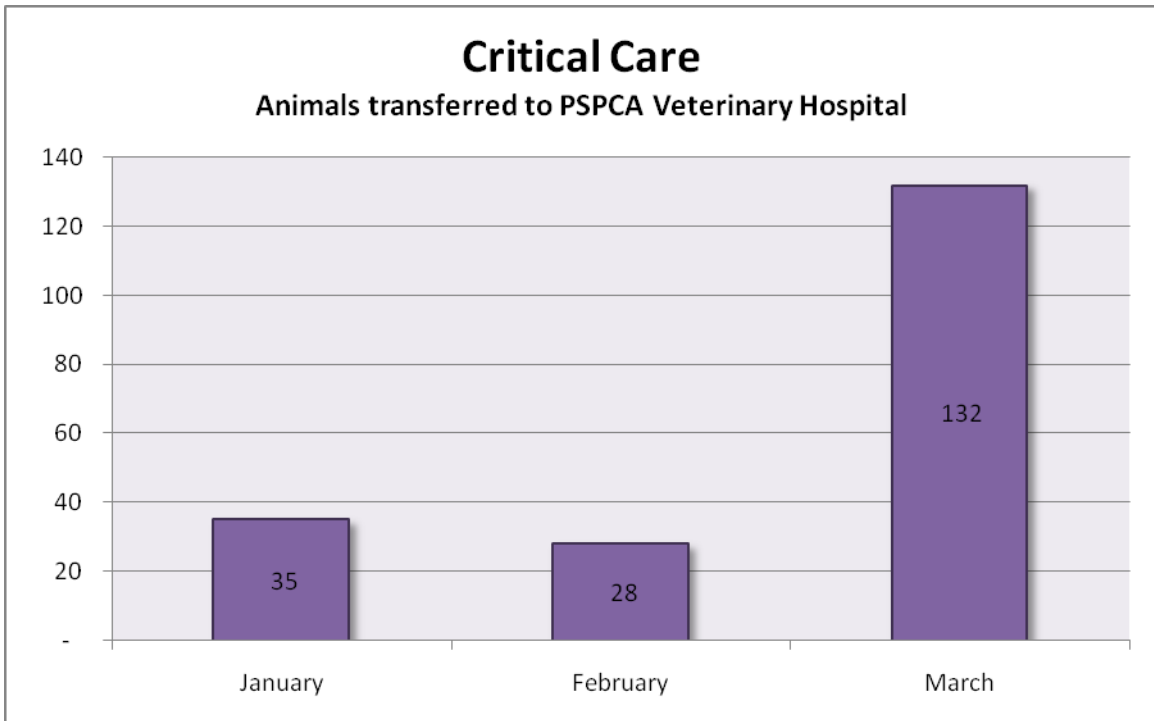


# 2009 Monthly Statistics for ACCT Medical Services

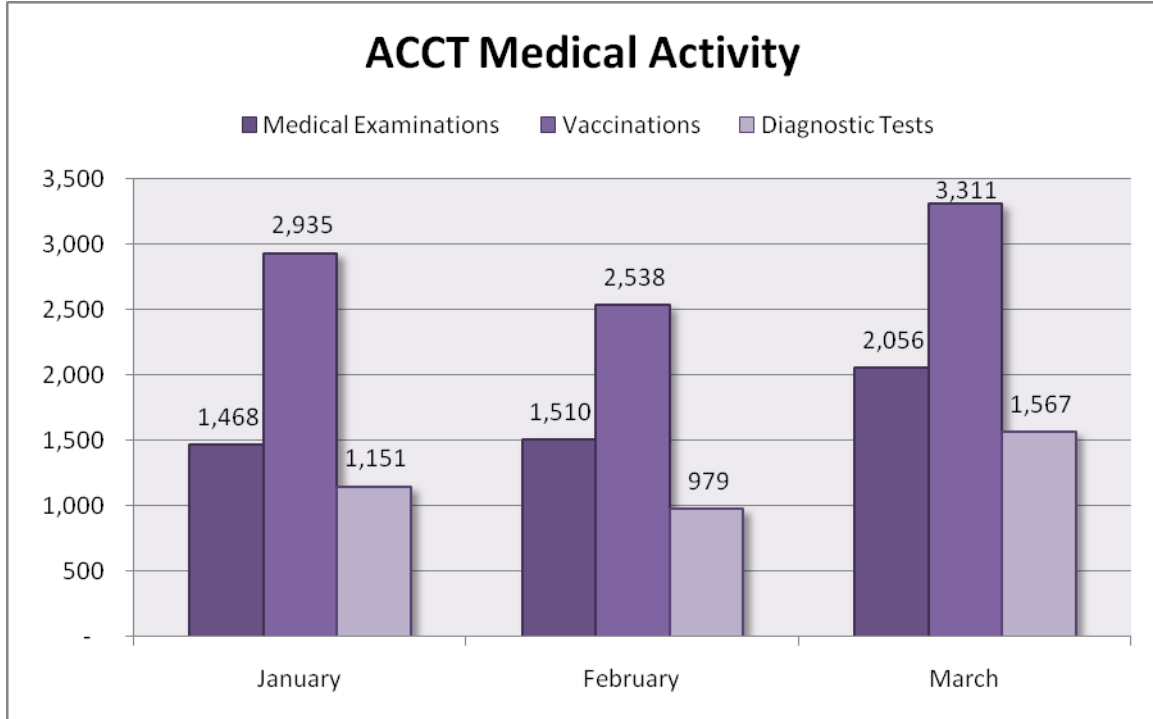


All animals in foster care receive Spay/Neuter surgeries prior to being placed in permanent homes.

# 2009 Monthly Statistics for ACCT Medical Services



Animals entering ACCT receive routine medical examinations that cover general health, diagnostic testing, intake procedures such as deworming and flea treatment, and vaccinations. Diagnostic tests for parvovirus, heartworm, FeLV and FIV are among the more common performed. All animals of an appropriate age and weight receive rabies vaccinations, as well as other core vaccinations such as FVRCP, DHLLP and Bordetella.
