Live Release Rate, as dictated by the Asilomar Accords, is calculated by dividing Total Live Outcomes (adoptions, outgoing transfers, and return to owner/guardian) by Total Outcomes (Total Live Outcomes plus euthanasia not including owner requested euthanasia). Because Administrative Transfers represent database maintenance and not actual live releases, they are not included in Total Live Outcomes. Additionally, in order to accurately represent the outcomes of animals in ACCT's care, those that were transferred to PSPCA Headquarters but were ultimately euthanized have been deducted from the ACCT Live Release Total and added to Euthanasia Total in the calculation.

The Live Release Rate does not include 3 owner requested euthanasias, 34 animals that died or were lost in the shelter/care, 158 animals that were dead on arrival, or 19 administrative transfers.

The **ACCT Foster Program** is one of the many life saving arms of the PSPCA. The primary reason for foster care is to provide a temporary home for a potentially adoptable animal whose current condition is not manageable in a shelter setting and to alleviate overcrowding. PSPCA ACCT receives more animals than there is space, and so moving animals into foster homes not only saves them, but also ensures that newly arriving animals have cage space.
