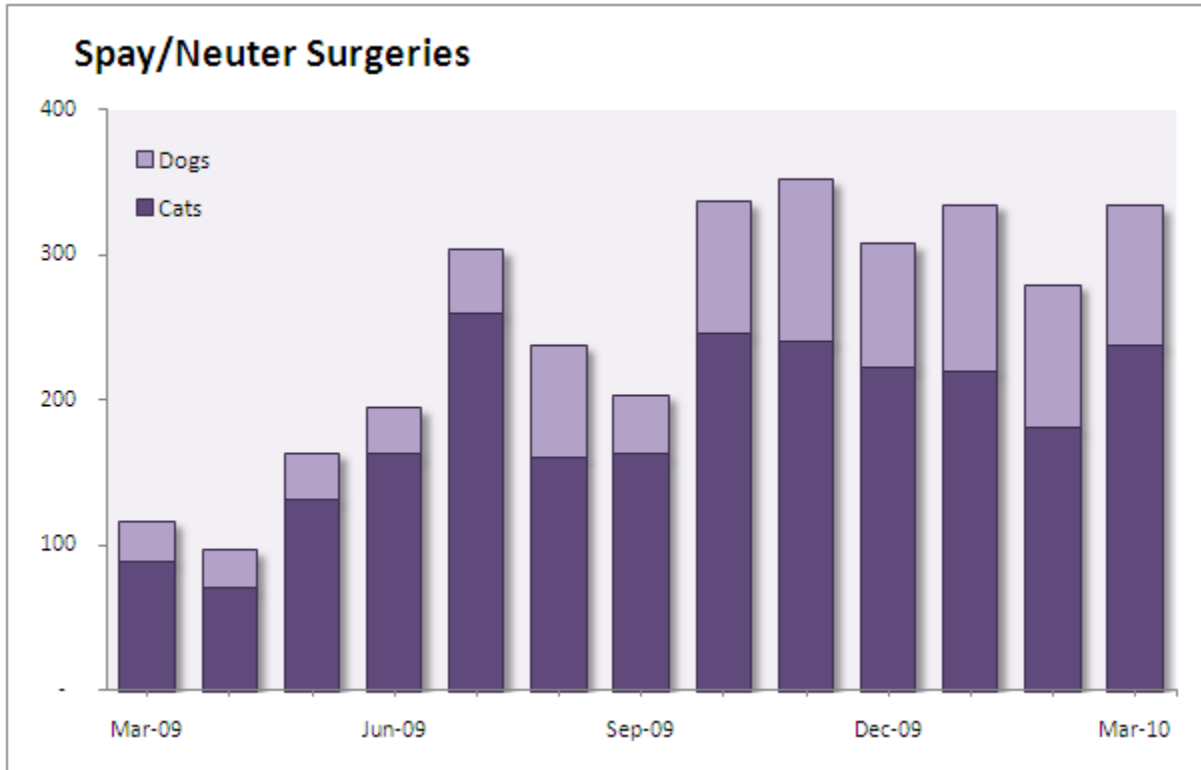


2010 Monthly Statistics for ACCT Medical Services

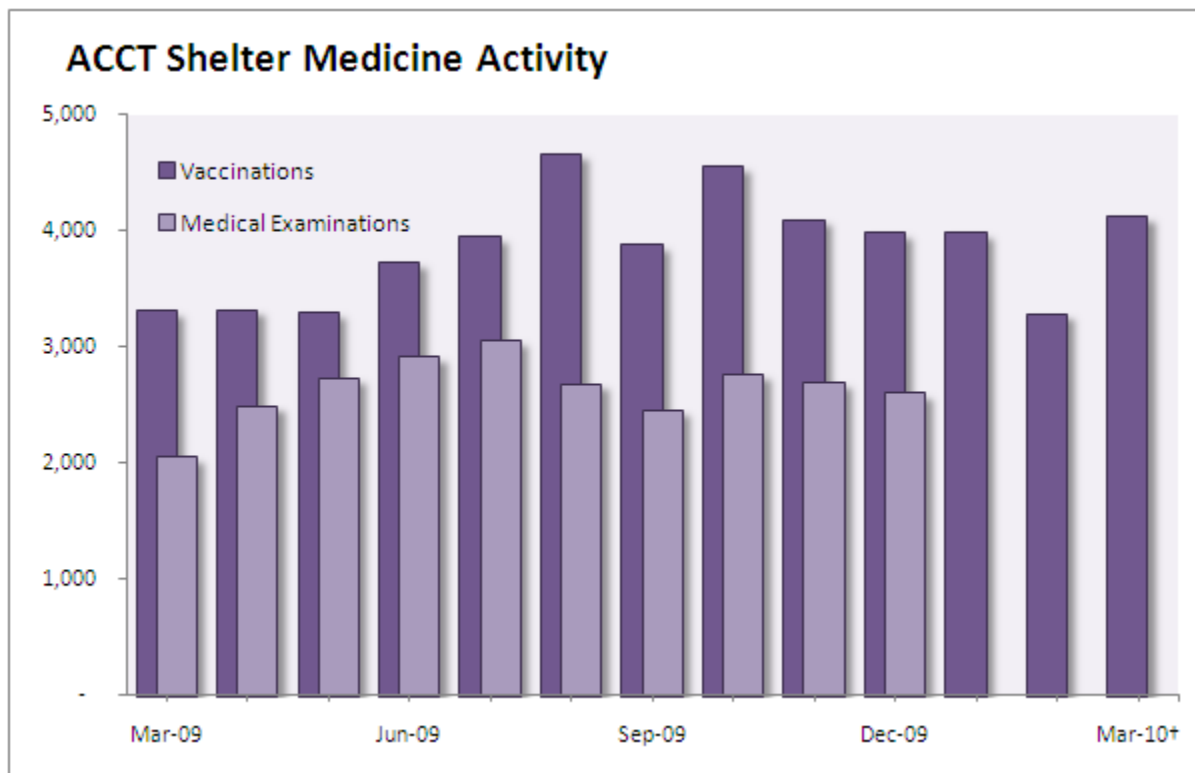


All animals in ACCT's care receive spay or neuter surgeries prior to being placed in permanent homes.



Animals requiring medical attention that cannot be administered at the ACCT Operations Center are transferred to the Pennsylvania SPCA Headquarters for critical care.

2010 Monthly Statistics for ACCT Medical Services



Animals entering ACCT receive routine medical examinations covering general health, vaccination, diagnostic testing, and intake procedures such as deworming and flea treatment. All animals of an appropriate age receive Rabies vaccinations, as well as other core vaccinations such as FVRCP, DHPP, Canine Influenza and Bordetella.
