## **Foster Care Program**

- The PSPCA provides free medical care at our animal hospital for foster animals
- Animals receive spay or neuter before adoption
- Foster care provider has first chance to adopt animal or arrange adoptions with qualified interested parties

### **To Become a Foster Parent:**

- You must be at least 18 or older
- You must submit an application
- You must sign a volunteer agreement
- You must be able to bring your foster in for inoculations and medical care
