Make checks or money orders payable to *Pennsylvania SPCA* and send it to Animal Care & Control Team, Attn: Dog Licensing, 111 W. Hunting Park Ave., Philadelphia, PA 19140. A license receipt and tag will be mailed to you.

**License Term:** Licenses will expire on the last day of the month, one year from last renewal or initial issuance. Permanent licenses are good for the life of your pet and never expire.

**Paperwork:** Please provide legible copies of any documentation requested. Paperwork is not returned with your license receipt.
