Primary responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Coordinate and mail of acquisition and renewal materials;
- Process gifts and in-kind donations via data entry;
- Pepare and mail acknowledgement letters;
- Participate in meetings to plan annual giving communications calendar and mailing timelines;
- Represent the Development Department at various fundraising events;
- Assist in coordinating and accommodating special donor requests; and
- Cultivate volunteer help, as needed.

Desired Experience & Skills:

- Strong editing and written skills, with particular capabilities in drafting clear, structured, articulate, and persuasive letters and/or reports;
- Creative thinker who is solution oriented:
- Excellent communication, organization, and attention to detail;
